Spiritwood Station is a combined heat and power plant located 80 miles west of Fargo, N.D. In addition to generating up to 99 megawatts of electricity, the plant produces approximately 555,000 pounds of steam per hour that is available for use by an interested agricultural or industrial enterprise.

Scheduled to come online in 2010, we can offer nominally 355,000 PPH of 150 PSIG saturated steam 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Spiritwood Station also provides 100 percent backup on steam supply using alternate fuel and equipment.

Spiritwood Station has excellent access right off BNSF mainline railroad and is located just three miles north of Interstate Highway 94.

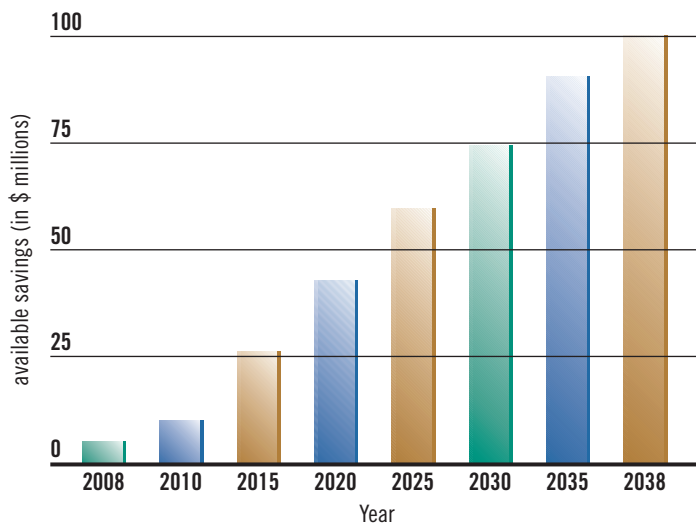
